

Current Events Group Presentation Rubric

Assignment: Think about our current world through the lens of digital culture & information. In your randomly assigned group, pick a current event that addresses one or more of the themes discussed in class: digital self, digital consumer, digital creator, democratic web, digital privacy, or online filter bubbles. Your group will take a class block (60 minutes) to teach us about your event & show us a piece of digital media that acts as a companion to your instruction.

Choose an article from a newspaper, magazine, or even a scholarly journal, & use the hour of class to present the information to your classmates/professors. Create some sort of media to enhance your presentation, such as, but not limited to: Slide deck – Video -Podcast/audio -Infographic - Digital game.
